- The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below and upto 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.

**SINGLE STAGE TWO ENVELOPS E-BIDDING SYSTEM INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS.**

1. **Bid Security 2% of the Estimated Cost in the shape of call deposit in (original) in the name of Executive Engineer Building Division-I Peshawar shall be sealed in separate envelope clearly marked as "Bid Security" and photocopy of CDR on account of bid security in hand.**
2. (i). The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security @ 2% only of Engineer Estimate  
(ii). The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below upto 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.  
(iii). [Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's Estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detailed rate analysis]<sup>vi</sup>. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and /or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the **2<sup>nd</sup> lowest bidder** and so on will be considered accordingly.  
(iv). In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the Procuring Entity, not convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.  
(v). The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity afresh.  
(vi). After commencements of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace the Additional Security with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank; if the already deposited security is not in the form of bank guarantee.  
(vii). The Additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project, 3<sup>rd</sup> installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the 4<sup>th</sup> installment of 25% to be released after 100% completion of the project.  
(viii). All previous orders, instructions and regulations issued regarding additional security shall stand superseded.

4. The Bidders are required to quote their rates (Electronically) "Above/Below/At Par" for both priced BOQ/Engineer Estimate based on MRS-2022 and NSI as well. Only Two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
5. **The Successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including Stamp Duty, Services Charges, Sales Tax and any other at prevailing rate.**
6. Technical evaluation will be carried out on the basis of (General experience, Personal Capability, Equipment Capabilities & Financial Soundness etc.) proper marking criteria as approved by Competent Authority. Failing to fulfill passing criteria shall be considered as fail leading to disqualification of the bidder.
7. Financial bid shall be filled online. Complete bids must reach the concerned offices on or before the fixed date/ time. **The C.D.R or Additional Security in the shape of call deposit (if required) shall be enclosed in sealed envelope in the Financial Bid Proposal.**
8. Any Electronic Bidder who provides incorrect information shall stand disqualified & De-Barred.
9. Electronic Bids validity period is 90 days.
10. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement and specifications with the department within Twenty Eight (28) days after issuance of L.O.A.
11. Call Deposit of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
12. Technical Bids will be opened after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/ their representatives who choose to be present.
13. **Financial Electronic bids will be opened after approval of Technical Bid from Competent Authority.**
14. **The Procurement Entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.**
15. **Bid security of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> lowest Electronic Bidder for the specific work will be retained by the Department till the approval of bids.**
