INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS
(KPPRA Single stage Single envelop bidding procedure)

1. Technical bid/ proposal should accompany the following:
 - (b) Certificate that that Bid Security, Stamp duty and Tender Form Fee in the shape of deposit at call (original) has been enclosed in financial bid.
 - (c) Enlistment Order of C&W Department for the year 2021-22 (Photocopy)
 - (d) Renewal of registration for 2021-22 (Photocopy)
 - (e) National Identity Card (CNIC Photocopy)
 - (f) Pakistan Engineering Council registration copy for calendar year 2021-22
 - (g) Form H of the Company / Firm.
 - (h) Documents showing general capabilities, financial soundness, general and relevant experience record, personnel capabilities, equipment capabilities and Income Tax / NTN Certificates.
 - (i) Any other document to support the technical/Financial bid.
2. Incomplete/ Conditional / Electronic bids and bids received after closing time shall not be entertained. Bids shall be signed by authorized persons.
3. The contractors quoting their bids up to the limit of 15% below Engineering Estimate shall submit bid security to the extent of 2% of Engineer Estimate only of the estimated cost in shape of call deposit (in Original) should be enclosed along with bidding documents.
4. The Contractors quoting their bids more than 15% below on Engineer's Estimate shall submit along with their bids an Additional Security to the extent of their bid/rates more than 15% below on Engineer estimate in the form of percentage.
5. In case the bidder quotes more than 15% below the Engineer Estimate and the bid is not accompanied by the Additional by the Additional Security then the bid shall be considered as non-responsive and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
6. In case a contractor quotes more than 30% below on Engineer Estimate, the procuring entity shall, in addition to additional security, require the contractor to produce detailed rate analysis of his bid price in relation to any or all the items of bill of quantities, scope of work, allocation of risks and responsibilities and/or any other requirements of the bid solicitation documents. The contract shall be awarded to the lowest evaluated bidder who has satisfied the procuring entity on rate analysis, however, if the procuring entity determines that the contractor has failed to demonstrate its capability to execute the contract at the offered price, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority for rejection of the bid on the basis of being financially unviable.
7. The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids and the market analysis in order to discourage cartel making and to protect public interest at large.
8. The additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments that is 25% to the release upon completion of 25% of the project, 50% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project, 75% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the remaining amount to be released after completion of the project.
9. Time to Time amendments by the KPPRA will be applicable before opening the tender, which will be hang up by Notice board.
10. Any bidder who provides incorrect/fake information should be disqualified.
11. Time allowed for completion of the work is as specified in the NIT which will start from the issuance of work order.
12. Bids will be valid for Ninety (90) days.
13. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with the department within stipulated time after acceptance of bid.
14. Call Deposit of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
15. If the evaluated bid costs of two or more than two bidders are same then the successful bid will be declared through draw.
16. Scanned copy of bid security i/c Tender fees shall be submitted electronically along with technical bid on E-Bidding System.
17. Bid security of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest electronic bidder for the specific work will be retained by the Department till the approval of bids.
18. The bidder must be enlisted with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority as per KPPRA Rules.
19. Pay Order is not acceptable as per Notification No. of KPPRA vide No. KPPRA/M&E/Estt:/1-12/2017-18, dated: 05/04/2018.
20. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act XXVII of 2019 2nd Schedule under S.No.14, in case of projects funded under the Government's ADP Budget, Tax shall be charged at the rate of Two Percent (2%).
