2. The bidders should submit their E-Bids as per KPPRA notification No. SOR (13)/Vol:1-21/2021 dated 15.09.2021.
3. Complete detail of bid security in shape of CDR i.e Bank Name, CDR number(s)and date(s)must be submitted electronically alongwith E-bid on the E-bidding system.
4. All bidders are required to be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority under Finance Act, 2013 Act No. XXI of 2013.
5. Venue of bids opening is office of the Executive Engineer C&W Division Chitral Upper.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS
(Single Stage Single Envelop E-Bidding System)

1. The bidders are required to quote their rates above or below on both MRS as well as on non MRS items.
2. The contractors quoting their bids upto a limit of 15% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security to the extent of 2% of Engineer Estimate only.
3. The contractors quoting their bids more than 15% below on Engineer's Estimate shall submit along with their bid an Additional Security to the extent of their bid/rates more than 15% below on Engineer Estimates in the form of Percentage.
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5. In case the bidder quotes more than 15% below the Engineer Estimates and the bid is not accompanied by the Additional Security then the bid shall be considered as non-responsive and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
6. In case a contractor quotes more than 30% below on Engineer Estimate, the procuring entity shall, in addition to additional security, require the contractor to produce Detailed Rate Analysis of his bid price in relation to any or all the items of bill of quantities, scope of work, allocation of risks and responsibilities and/or any other requirements of the bid solicitation document. The contract shall be awarded to the lowest evaluated bidder who has satisfied the procuring entity on Rate Analysis. However, if the procuring entity determines that the contractor has failed to demonstrate its capability to execute the contract at the offered price, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority for rejection of the bid on the basis of being financially unviable.
7. The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement afresh.
8. After commencements of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace the Additional Security with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank: if the already deposited security is not in the form of bank guarantee.
9. The Additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments i.e. 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project. 50% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project. 75% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the remaining amount to be released after completion of the project.
10. All such effort to conspire to cartel making shall be considered as violation of Rule-44 and shall be attributed towards mis-procurement under Rule-54 of procurement Rules ibid.
11. Electronic Bids should be submitted electronically on or before the fixed date/time.
12. Any bidder who provides incorrect information shall stand disqualified and will be debarred.
13. Time allowed for completion of the work is as specified in the NIT which will start from the issuance of LOA.
14. Electronic Bids will valid for Ninety (90) days.
15. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with the department within Twenty Eight (28) days after acceptance of bid.
16. Call Deposit of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
17. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bidder will be declared through draw.
18. Electronic Bids will be displayed by Online E-Bidding System after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/their representatives who choose to be present.
19. The employer has the authority to reject any E-bid or all the E-bids assigning valid reason.
20. Bid Security of 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders will be retained by the employer till approval of bid.
