As recommended by Procurement Committee & forwarded vide your letter under reference the lowest rate of 20 % below Schedule Items and non-scheduled item on BOQ based on MRS-2024 (1st Bi.Annual) electronically uploaded by M/S Falak Niaz Constructor Government Contractor for net bid cost of Rs.19.280 (M) being the lowest and selected through toss for the above cited work is hereby approved subject to the following conditions.

1. Fulfillment of all codal & financial formalities.
2. The Executive Engineer/Sub Divisional Officer and Sub Engineer In-charge are responsible for the execution of the work according to the specification, approved scope of work provided in the Administrative Approval, authenticity of the rates provided in the BOQ and adherence to the contract agreement.
3. The work may be completed in stipulated period & Technical Sanction from the Competent Authority must be obtained before commencement of the work. The work order should only be issued after fulfilment of all codal formalities.
4. The contractor be directed to sign the Contract Agreement before commencement of the work and be asked to submit work plan immediately, for approval of the Executive Engineer and the work shall commence after availability of funds.
5. The Executive Engineer and Consultants (if any) while issuing the work order should specify the quarry/sources of the basic materials to the contractor to ensure good quality of work and also carrying out required material tests.
6. The Executive Engineer /Head Clerk concerned shall be responsible for correctness and validity of the contractors enlistment with the Department, PEC. and transparency of bidding.
7. The XEN shall be responsible for the specification and quantities indicated in the BOQ.
8. Tender Opening committee will be held responsible for any error found in arithmetical calculations of the quoted bids at any stage.
9. Each payment will be supported by Material Test Result. A test profile may be maintained for the project.
10. In case of Non-Schedule Items (NSI), the detail analysis must be approved from the authority concerned under relevant clause of Contract Agreement before issuance of work order.
11. Income tax and Stamp duty shall be recovered from the contractor as per rules /SROs. And professional tax will be deposited by the contractor.
12. CDRs/SDRs as 2 % E/Money as well as Additional Security of the lowest bidder should be verified from the concerned Bank, regarding the ownership of account and its verification before issuance of work order and make it part & parcel of the tender documents. Additional security of the contractor shall be released as per KPPRA Notification No.S.R.O(14)/Vol-1-24/2021 -22 dated May 10,2022
