





NOTICE INVITING ELECTRONIC BIDS ON (E-PADS)

**SINGLE STAGE TWO ENVELOP E-PAK ACQUISITION & DISPOSAL
SYSTEM (E-PADS).**

The **C&W Department Office of the Executive Engineer Building Division-I Peshawar** Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa invites Electronic Bids from the Eligible Firms/Bidders in accordance with KPPRA Procurement Rules 2014 on Single Stage Two Envelop Procedure for the below mentioned works. The Bidders should be registered with KPPRA & Pakistan Engineer Council (P.E.C) for the Year 2025-26 in relevant category & field of specialization, enlisted with C&W Department.

1. Bidding Solicitation Documents and instruction to bidders can be downloaded from the official EPADS website and C&W website (www.cwd.gkp.pk) as well as KPPRA website (www.kppra.go.pk) before the submission time. Bids submitted without requisite documents or incomplete will not be processed further for Technical Evaluation.
2. **Bidders must submit an affidavit on Judicial Stamp Paper & (Non-Judicial Stamp Paper Not Acceptable) with the Technical Proposal confirming that the CDR in the sealed Financial Bid is original and authentic; otherwise the bid will be considered non-responsive.**
3. All the bidders will have to submit CDR from scheduled Bank on Account of bidding entry fee (Not refundable) for each bid @0.03% of the estimated cost without fail, otherwise his bid will not be entertained.
4. **Original CDR for Bid Security (from a Scheduled Bank), Stamp Duty, and Bid Entry Fee @0.03% of the estimated cost must be submitted with the Technical Proposal before the closing date/time.**
5. A copy of the Technical Proposal as well as Financial Securities in the required format is mandatory and to be uploaded on EPADS System.
6. Electronic bidding will be done on **"ABOVE/BELOW/ATPAR"** system on BOQ/ Engineer's Estimate, based on MRS applicable. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purposes.
7. Electronic Bids will be displayed by online E-Bidding through EPADS system after 30-Miutes of closing time in presence of bidders/their representative.
8. Bid Security of 1st, 2nd & 3rd lowest bidder will be retained by the Procuring Entity till approval of the bid.
9. Any bidder who provides incorrect information shall stand disqualified and will be debarred.
10. The competent Authority reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders by assigning the cogent reason(s).
11. Bid will be valid for (90) days.
12. Details of similar nature and other general works, in hand and completed during last five years supported by work orders and Completion Certificates duly attested form Executing Agencies concerned.
13. Machinery (Tools, Plants & Equipment etc.) supported with the purchase documents as evidence of ownership
14. **Details of Technical Staff/Engineers with updated CVs, qualifications, and agreement with the firm on Judicial Stamp Paper & (Non-Judicial Stamp Paper Not Acceptable) (for the current year) must be provided, along with an affidavit confirming their availability for the project, including PEC registration numbers and contact details. Financial soundness supported by annual Audit reports for the current year.**
15. **List of Staff, List Of Machinery, Affidavit must be provide in the Judicial Stamp Paper & (Non-Judicial Stamp Paper Not Acceptable).**
16. Tax Returned Certificate for the Current Financial Year.
17. All other terms and conditions, including KPPRA amended rules, can be obtained from the C&W Department website or the office of the undersigned during working hours.
18. All Federal / Provincial duties / Stamp duties / Taxes will be recovered as per direction of the Government issued from time to time.
19. The Participating contractors(s) must submit their updated FBR (Active Status), KPRA (Active Status), PEC License and C&W Enlistment copies for the current financial year, on the day of opening of tender(s).
20. All bidders are required to be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) under Finance Act, 2013 Act No. XXI of 2013.
21. The Financial Bid will be opened after the approval of Technical Bids from the Competent Authority.
22. Period of Completion will be based on Work Order(s).
23. Any condition/Instructions, if missing will be dealt in light of KPPRA rules.
24. Contractors whose past performance is not satisfactory with this Division shall be considered non-responsive.
25. Venue of bids opening is office of the Executive Engineer C&W Building Division-I Bacha Khan Chowk Peshawar

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS (ITB)

Technical Proposal should be accompanied with the following:

1. Bidder shall submit an affidavit that Sealed Envelopes submitted along-with Technical proposal contains 2% Earnest Money.
2. The bidders should submit their E-bids as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O. (14)/Vol: 1-24/2021-22: Dated 10/05/2022.
3. Copies of valid registration with PEC, FBR and KPRA – Active Tax Payer
4. Copy of valid Enlistment Certificate of C&WD for the Current Year
5. National Identity Card (CNIC photocopy)
6. Form H in case of Company / Firm.
7. Detail of similar nature and other general works, in hands and completed during last five years supported by work orders and completion certificates duly attested from Executing Agencies concerned.
8. Machinery (Tools, Plants & Equipment etc.) supported with the purchase documents as evidence of ownership.
9. Particular of technical Staff/engineers along with updated CVs and their agreement (for the current year) on stamp paper with the firm together with their qualification. Affidavit to the effect that the said personnel or their equivalent shall be made available for the job should also be given along with their registration number of PEC and contact numbers.
10. Financial soundness supported by annual audit reports for the current year.
11. Tax Return Certificate for the current year.
12. Any other document to support the technical bid.
13. Evaluation of Technical Proposal will be carried out with pass/ fail threshold in passing all the field including PEC registration in relevant code, Enlistment with C&W in relevant code, Tax payer proof, relevant experience in past five years, performance, technical personnel, required equipment, financial status, auditors reports, managerial capabilities, litigation status etc. Evaluation criteria in this regard can be obtained from office of the undersigned on any working day in office hours or can be downloaded from the official website of C&WD.
14. All the bidding will be through E-PADS system. Technical Bid should in sealed envelope clearly marked: "Technical bid" addressed to the Executive Engineer C&W Highway Division-II Peshawar and shall be submitted through Pakistan Post/UMS/Courier before closing time.
15. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE/BELOW/AT PAR" for both priced BOQ/Engineer Estimate based on MRS-2025 and NSI as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
16. The successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including Stamp duty, service charges, sales tax and any other at prevailing rate.
17. Financial Bid shall be filled online. Complete bid must reach this office on or before the fix date and time.
18. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of work order.
19. Electronic Bid validity period is 90-days.
20. Successful Bidders should sign the Agreement with C&WD within (28) days after issuance of letter acceptance.
21. Call deposit and Bank guarantee of scheduled banks shall be acceptable.
22. If the evaluated electronic bid cost of two or more than two bidders are equal than the successful bid will be declared through open draw.
23. Those Bidders have not submitted the tender fee (previously) shall be considered an eligible and their bids will not be entertained.
24. The procuring entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.
25. Bid Security of 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the authority till the approval of bids.
26. All the information and documents provided by the bidders must be based on fact beyond any doubt. Any miss representation, false statements or fact documents found in the proposal at any stage, would lead to the debarment/ black listing of the firm. The matter may also be reported to the PEC for cancellation of registration/ License of the respective firm.
27. Financial Electronic bids will be opened after approval of technical evaluation.
28. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, established under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXI of 2013), for works, consulting and non-consulting services as listed in schedule-II of the Act ibid.
29. During the E-Bidding for Technical Proposal a separate form should be filled along with Financial Bid which is available on the C&W website.
