1. Bid documents and instruction to bidders can be downloaded up to one day prior to the opening date from C&W web

2. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, Enlistment with C&W Department & Pakistan Engineering Council in relevant category/specialty.

3. Complete detail of Bid Security in shape of CDR i.e Bank Name, CDR Number(s), Date(s) must be submitted

4. As per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O. (14)/Vol:1-24/2021-22 dated 10/05/2022 the additional Security shall be submitted

i. The contractors quoting their bids upto a limits of 10% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security @ 2% only

ii. The contractor quoting their bids more than 10% below upto 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security, then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered

iii. Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer Estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and engineers' Estimate along with detailed rate analysis. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and / or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favour Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and

iv. In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the Procuring Entity, not convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons

v. The procuring entity may offer contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference

The additional Security shall be released to the contractor in 4-installments i.e 1st installment of 25% to be release on completion of 25% of project, 2nd installment of 25% to be released on completion of 50% project, 3nd installment of 25% to be released upon 75% of project completion & final installment to be released on 100% of project completion.

5. Bid shall accompany with 0.03% of E/Cost as tender entry fee in shape of separate CDR which is non-refundable. After commencement of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace additional security with a bank

guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank, if the already deposited security is not in the form of Bank

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
