NOTICE INVITING TENDERS ON EPAD SYSTEM

(Single Stage Two Envelope Procedure)

Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA) invites Bids from all eligible firms / contractors in accordance with "KPPRA Procurement Rules 2014" on "Single Stage Two Envelope" procedure for the following works. The Bidders registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPR) & Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in relevant category & field of specialization having adequate financial soundness, relevant experience, personnel capabilities, required equipment & other requirements as included in ITB / Bidding Documents can participate in the tender for the following scheme:

- A pre-bid Joint Venture (JV) comprising bidders holding at least a C-1 or higher category of PEC will also be eligible to participate in the bidding process. A duly signed JV agreement must be submitted along with the Technical Proposal. The Technical Bids of the JV will be evaluated in accordance with the share percentage specified in the JV agreement executed among the participating firms.
- Bidding documents including Priced BOQ / Engineer Estimate, instruction to bidders (ITB), evaluation criteria etc. are available on PKHA web site (www.pkha.gov.pk) which can be downloaded for bidding purpose.
- The bidders are instructed to submit their bids through **E-PAD System** via <https://kp.eprocure.gov.pk>
- Both the Technical and Financial Bids must be submitted through the EPADS portal. In addition, hard copies of the bids must also be submitted to the office of the Deputy Director (Procurement), PKHA, at Attached Departments Complex, Gate No. 5, Khyber Road, Peshawar. Bidders failing to submit their bids through both systems shall be declared non-responsive, and their bids shall not be considered for evaluation.
- Call Deposits / Bank Guarantee of scheduled banks in favor of the Managing Director PKHA shall be accepted.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

1. Technical proposal should accompany the following:

- a. The bid security shall be kept sealed in the financial proposal. The bidder shall in addition, place an affidavit in the technical proposal stating that a bid security amounting to 2% without indicating the figure in the letter, has been placed in the financial proposal or bid. Otherwise, the technical proposal will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the bidder after being examined by the procurement committee.
- b. A letter of intent addressed to Managing Director – PKHA.
- c. The title page of brochure shall also contain the nomenclature of the work for which the bidder intends to apply.
- d. Copy of valid Registration with PEC having at least CE01 and CE02 codes.
- e. Copy of valid Registration with KPRA.
- f. Copy of valid Enlistment Certificate of C&WD.
- g. National Identity Card (CNIC Photocopy)
- h. Form H of the Company / Firm.
- i. Details of similar nature works, in hands and completed during last 10-years supported by work orders & completion certificates duly attested from the Executing agencies concerned.
- j. Machinery (Tools, Plants & Equipment etc.) supported with the purchase documents as evidence of ownership.
- k. Particular of technical staff / Engineers along with updated CVs and their agreement (for the current year) on stamp paper with the firm together with their qualification. Affidavit to the effect that the said personnel or their equivalent shall be made available for the job should also be given along with their registration number of PEC and contact numbers.
- l. Financial soundness supported by annual audit reports for the latest year.
- m. Tax Return Certificate for the latest year.
- n. Any other document to support the technical bid.

2. **The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security @ 2% only of Engineer Estimate.**

3. **The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.**


4. **[Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's Estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detailed rate analysis].** In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and / or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.

5. In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the PKHA, not convincing, the Managing Director – PKHA may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.

6. Technical evaluation will be carried out with pass / fail threshold and Evaluation criteria in this regard can be obtained from office of the undersigned on any working day in office hours or can be downloaded from the EPADS or official websites of PKHA.



7. All the bidding will be through E-PADS system. Technical bid should be in sealed envelopes clearly marked "Technical Bid" and shall be submitted through Pakistan Post / UMS / Courier before closing time.
8. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE / BELOW / AT PAR" for both priced BOQ / Engineer Estimate based on MRS-2024 (1st Bi-Annual) and NSI Items as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
9. All other items not mentioned in the BOQ but exist in the MRS-2024 (1st Bi-Annual) shall be paid at contractor's rate approved by the Competent Authority with approved area cost factor.
10. The Successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including stamp duty, service charges, sale tax and any other at prevailing rate.
11. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of Work Order.
12. Electronic Bids validity period is 120-days.
13. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with PKHA within Twenty-Eight (28) days after issuance of Acceptance Letter.
14. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bid will be declared through *Open Bowl Technique*.
15. The Procuring Entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.
16. Bid security of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the Authority till the approval of bids.
17. A Pre-bid meeting will be held in the office of the undersigned on 26/06/2025 at 11:00 am for clarification of information regarding the schemes
18. Any clarification regarding bidding documents required, must be communicated on or before 27/06/2025 till 05:00 PM on EPAD System.
19. All the information and documents provided by the bidder must be based on facts beyond any doubt. During analysis / Scrutiny or evaluation of the proposals any misrepresentation, false statement or fake document would make a ground for rejection of the bid and will also be liable for debarment / blacklisting. Any fake document or misrepresentation detected during the currency of the contract, will render the firm to be black listed and would be reported to the PEC for cancellation of their registration/license.
